The Keokuk Public Library Foundation is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization that was formed in 1987, to encourage private giving to the Keokuk Public Library.

Here is what the Foundation did for us in 2011/2012!

- ◆ Facilitated grants for six new laptops for free basic computer classes at the library.
- ◆ Fixed vandalized window and broken door frame.
- ◆ Paid for professional architect services for building improvement projects, including window replacement, tile replacement, and space planning. **Replaced damaged front lobby and alley-side windows in 2012!**
- ◆ Received and spent memorial money on new books and toys for the children's area.
- ◆ Paid for three new do-it-yourself online reference databases.
- ◆ Paid almost \$3,000 for programs for adults and children, including Winter Reading Program prizes.

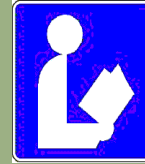

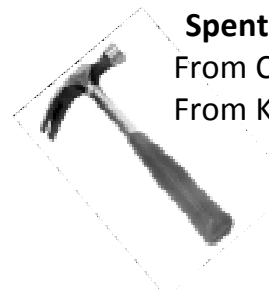
